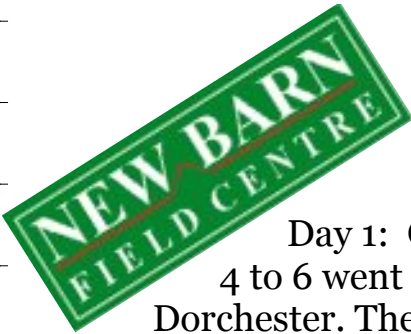




# New Barn Field Trip Report
