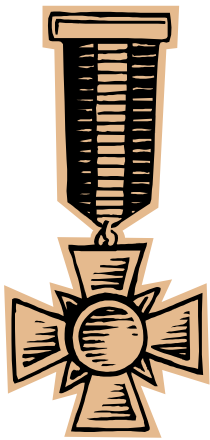


# History Day
